



### **2008 Big Year for Centre PhD Student**

2008 was a big year for Centre PhD student Caragh Threlfall. She was awarded the 2008 ESA's Jill Landsberg Trust grant, a Royal Zoological Society of NSW grant, the MA Ingram Trust grant, the Kuringai Bat Conservation Society grant and the Joyce Vickery Research Grant from the Linnean Society.

Caragh is doing her PhD in Peter Banks' lab on *Insectivorous bats in the Sydney Region: urban ecology of an over-looked fauna*.

Her research project aims to significantly fill the gaps in our knowledge of the ecology of insectivorous bats in urban environments, using Sydney as the study area.
